F-103.2.9.5 Hurricane Protection Devices.

After the termination of such periods of time that have been designated by the National Weather Service as being a hurricane watch or warning, hurricane protective devices installed on occupied buildings which impede required egress or required light and ventilation shall be removed within 15 days.

Bottom Line:

Snowbirds can place hurricane shutters up when they leave at end of season and take them down when they return next season legally with no fines or fees, as long as their units are UNOCCUPIED for that interim period.
