AVOID GETTING LOCKED OUT

Your unit key required by law to give the Association is for **ASSOCIATION EMERGENCY use only**...NOT for convenience if you get locked out.

Please **DO NOT** rely on Board members to open your door for you.



Two great ways to avoid being locked out of your unit are:

1. Use top DEADBOLT LOCK only. A deadbolt provides better protection. Those of us with NO bottom lock using deadbolt ONLY never get locked out. We must have the key with us to lock the deadbolt when we leave. Many place tape on bottom lock as reminder not to lock/press.

2. Always have an extra key handy by placing a key lockbox on your door. You can buy them at Home Depot, Lowes, a locksmith, etc. Get one easy for you to use and always keep your key locked in it so you, condo sitter, guest always have access to an extra key when you need it.

A backup option to above is sharing a key with a trusted friend/neighbor. Can be helpful for lots of reasons, including if they are home when locked out.

Whatever you chose to help you long-term, please place a 2nd key somewhere safe for your personal use in the event you are locked out.

Please do not rely on Board members to open your door for you.
